Attention Deficit Disorder Treatment Instructions

Thank you for entrusting us with your child's Attention Deficit Disorder management. We strive to provide consistent and reliable care for your child. To optimize your child's treatment, please help us by adhering to the following guidelines:

- Regular rechecks are required to ensure that your child is doing well on the medication with minimal side effects. We require that your child is checked in the office within 4-6 weeks of starting the medication, and then a minimum of every 6 months after that (the yearly well checks will count as one of these visits). Your doctor will advise you if the child needs more frequent follow-up. We ask that you have Vanderbilt forms filled out and returned to us before each recheck.
- You must make your child's medication rechecks and well checks with the doctor who is prescribing the medication.
- We ask that you make a request for medication refills a minimum of 5 days prior to running out of medication. This allows our physicians the time it takes to review each chart, arrange for further follow-up if necessary, and to write the requested prescription as appropriate.
- Because these medications are controlled substances, we request that you bring a photo ID
 when you pick up your child's medication. No child under the age of 18 may pick up their own
 medication. All medication must be signed for by a parent or legal guardian. If you wish to have
 someone, over the age of 18, pickup medication on your behalf we MUST have a signed consent
 form on file.
